



Dependent Children

Dependent children at Norjam are those aged 17 or under, who are not registered as a participant with a Scout or Guide Contingent Group.

Contingent Group Dependent Children

Dependent children of leaders are defined as under 10 years of age and registered as a dependent child. Therefore, they are not allowed to take part in any activities provided for Scouts and Guides at the Jamboree.

Opportunity 1: Children who are not yet participant age (under 10 years) are eligible to join "Side Show Fiesta". This will provide one 90-minute session per day at the Jamboree.

Numbers are limited and there is an additional charge of £35 for the week or part thereof, making a total fee of £70 for those aged 5 to 9 years and £35 for those aged 2 to 4 years. Places must be applied for and confirmed as part of the stage 2 registration process and an appropriate adult must attend the activity session and remain with the child at all times.

Staff Team Dependent Children

Dependent children of staff are defined as under 18 years of age and registered as a dependent child. Therefore, they are not allowed to take part in any activities provided for Scouts and Guides at the Jamboree, unless buying into Opportunity 2.

Opportunity 1: Children who are not yet participant age (under 10 years) are eligible to join "Side Show Fiesta". This will provide one 90-minute session per day at the Jamboree.

Numbers are limited and there is an additional charge of £35 for the week or part thereof, making a total fee of £70 for those aged 5 to 9 years and £35 for those aged 2 to 4 years. Places must be applied for and confirmed as part of the stage 2 registration process and an appropriate adult must attend the activity session and remain with the child at all times.

Opportunity 2: Children who are participant age (10 to 17 years) are eligible to join as a participant and take part in all the activities offered onsite at Norjam. There is an additional charge of £240.00 for the week or part thereof, making a total fee of £275.00 to access all the onsite activities. Places must be booked as part of the stage 2 registration process and arrangements will be made for staff children to meet and take part in the activities as part of an age-related activity group.

All children aged under 10 remain the responsibility of their parents and must be appropriately supervised at all times.

Staff children aged 10 to 17 years, that have not bought into Option 2 (the additional activity package), remain the responsibility of their parents and must be appropriately supervised at all times and cannot access any Jamboree activities.

All parents must make suitable arrangements to ensure that supervision of their child or children does not conflict with their Jamboree role, whether attending as a member of a contingent group or part of the staff team.
